We reserve the right to change or cancel the published trip including destination, times or content without prior notification should we be delayed or be unable to visit on the day shown for any reason beyond our control.


Due to the recent increase in fuel prices we have had to increase the cost of fares. Hopefully we will see this trend finish soon and we can get back to the fares we know. and expect.


The Catherine Wheel has been a pub of this name for more than 400 years, located in Hart Street, Henley's oldest street, there has been a pub of this name for more than 400 years.


